Part of the Duff House Masterpiece Series from the National Gallery of Scotland, Edinburgh. FREE ENTRY

This fantastical work is an imaginative interpretation of an incident in Shakespeare's play 'A Midsummer Night's Dream'. Oberon and Titania, king and queen of the fairies, quarrel over the possession of a changeling (a human child carried off to the fairy realm and replaced by a fairy child). In 1850 the painting captivated Lewis Carroll (the author of 'Alice in Wonderland') who counted 165 fairies.
